

# THEFT SECURITY CODING



## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

## COVERAGE HIGHLIGHTS

Up to \$25,000 benefit if vehicle is stolen and declared a total loss.

## WHAT IS SECURITY CODING?

- Vehicle security coding uses a stencil and acid, or a laser, to permanently mark your vehicle's glass or body panels with a unique Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) or a traceable code.
- Registered in a national theft recovery database

## REPLACEMENT EXAMPLE:

New 2008 vehicle value (in 2011): \$30,000

Insurance payout: \$15,000

Actual 2012 replacement cost: \$35,000

**Ascent pays the \$20,000 difference**

## VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY

All vehicles are eligible.

## KEY BENEFITS

### DETERRENCE

- Thieves are less likely to target a vehicle with visible traceable markings

### TRACEABILITY
